

Tasmanian Honour Roll of Women 2026-27 NOMINATION FORM

Introduction

The Tasmanian Honour Roll of Women recognises and celebrates Tasmanian women and women's organisations who have made a significant contribution in Tasmania, across Australia, or internationally.

The Honour Roll:

- shares the stories and achievements of Tasmanian women
- preserves these stories as part of Tasmania's history
- inspires future generations
- showcases contributions from many fields such as community service, science, the arts, sport, education, business, public service, environment, and more.

Nominations for the 2026-27 Induction open at 9:00am on 2 June 2026, and close at 2.00pm on 30 September 2026.

Late nominations will not be accepted.

We encourage nominations of women and organisations representing diverse communities, including Aboriginal women, women from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds and those from the LGBTIQ+ community.

Who can be nominated?

Individual women

You can nominate a woman who:

- identifies as a woman
- has made significant contribution at local, state, national, or international level
- was born in Tasmania, has lived in Tasmania for a significant period, or has made a meaningful contribution to Tasmania.

Women from all backgrounds are welcome, including:

- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander women
- women from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds

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- LGBTIQ+ women
- women of all ages.

You can nominate someone who is no longer living. For nominees who have recently passed away, we require permission from the senior next-of-kin.

Serving Members of Parliament and Vice-Regal office holders cannot be considered while in office.

Women's organisations

An organisation can be nominated if:

- it has significantly contributed to the Tasmanian women's sector
- its core work is focused on Tasmania.

Nominations should be for the overarching organisation, not individual branches. Organisations that are no longer operating can also be nominated.

How do I make a nomination?

- Anyone can nominate a woman or women's organisation (called a nominee).
- Nominations must be submitted by an individual other than the nominee, or by an organisation.
- You must be familiar with the nominee's work and be able to discuss their achievements in detail.

What information should I include?

The nomination form allows for up to **800 words** describing the nominee's achievements. Provide clear, relevant information addressing the following criteria:

- Contribution to the Tasmanian community
- How they inspire and act as a role model
- Personal, academic, community and/or professional achievements
- Efforts to advance social justice and equality
- Leadership and contribution in their field
- Contribution to regional communities
- Degree of difficulty of their achievements
- Volunteer work

IMPORTANT TO NOTE:

All nominations are assessed by a panel of community representatives, and a nomination does not necessarily mean that it will be successful.

Serving MP's/Vice-Regal office holders cannot be considered while still serving.

Performance of business-as-usual duties or role is not necessarily sufficient or a necessary criterion to be nominated.

There are no age restrictions for individual nominees. Posthumous nominations are accepted. You can nominate an **INDIVIDUAL** to the Honour Roll if they:

- identify as a woman;
- have made a significant contribution at a local, state or national level; and
- were born in Tasmania, have spent a considerable part of their life in Tasmania, or have made a significant contribution to Tasmania.

You can nominate an **ORGANISATION** to the Honour Roll if:

- it has significantly contributed to the Tasmanian women's sector
- its core work is focused on Tasmania.

Nominations should be for the overarching organisation, not individual branches. Organisations that are no longer operating can also be nominated.

Selection of new members will be guided by the following criteria:

- contribution to the Tasmanian community
- how they inspire others and act as a role model
- personal, academic, community and/or professional achievements
- efforts to advance social justice and equality
- leadership and contribution in their field
- contribution to regional communities
- the degree of difficulty or challenges overcome in achieving their outcomes
- volunteer work

Contributions can be at any level — local (grassroots), state, national or international.

Please don't assume the Community Panel is familiar with the nominee.

A strong application clearly explains the nominee's contribution and supports it with relevant examples.

- Provide a short background about the nominee.
- Explain why they should be inducted.
- Describe how their actions have supported or advanced women in Tasmania.
- Include examples of leadership, advocacy, mentoring, or support for others.

What happens next?

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- Submitting a nomination does not guarantee induction.
- Departmental staff will review your nomination. They may contact you (the nominator) if they need more information. Nominees will only be contacted with your permission.
- The Honour Roll has an exemption under the [Personal Information Protection Act 2024](#) to allow the collection of personal information for this process.
- The recipient will be asked if they are happy for their nomination to also be considered for the Order of Australia awards process
- OPTIONAL: Please provide the names of any additional referees (ideally up to two) who can support your nomination of this individual, if possible. These referees may be contacted if the individual is considered for other awards, including the Order of Australia."

Assessment

A Community Panel, selected through an Expressions of Interest process, assesses all nominations.

The panel considers:

- 1.The nominee's personal, professional, academic and community achievements, and their impact.
- 2.Collaboration and influence beyond their immediate role or field.
- 3.Long term benefits of their work for the community.
- 4.The nature and length of their involvement.

The panel provides recommendations to a Departmental delegate, who makes the final decision on successful inductees.

Successful nominations

- If your nomination is successful, the recipient (or their representative) will be contacted and invited to attend a ceremony.
- We will use the information in the nomination to write a short biography about the recipient.
- The recipient (or their representative) will be asked to check the biography and confirm that the details are correct.
- Once approved, the biography will be shared on the Women in Tasmania website, on social media, and with news outlets.
- Inductees will be announced on or around International Women's Day 8 March 2027.

Photographs

We publish a photograph alongside every inductee on the Tasmanian Honour Roll of Women.

- This can be a photograph of a person, or something that represents the individual or organisation (for example a statue).
- We no longer require a photograph with the nomination form, but will request a relevant photograph for each successful inductee.
